

BEDGEBURY FOREST
DIRECTIONS TO THE NEW BOX PARK
(just past the District Offices)

The Box Park & FC District Offices are off the B2079 Bedgebury Road which runs between Goudhurst village and the A21. The approach road, private drive & public bridle path, runs parallel to the main Bedgebury School Driveway.

1. If travelling from the A21:

You will first pass the new entrance to Bedgebury Pinetum on your right (go past this). Go past the old entrance to Bedgebury Pinetum on right; high brick walls and pair of massive green iron gates!

Take the next turn/entrance on the right which has a green FC sign at end saying Forest District Offices then follow directions in 3. below:

2. If travelling from Goudhurst village:

Travel approx 1.5 miles from village, you will come upon a private entrance on left which says something like Bedgebury Estate or Park **THIS IS NOT IT!** You will come to grand entrance for Bedgebury School on left. Go just past this entrance.

3. Take very next entrance which has FC sign at end saying Forest District Offices

Once you turn into private driveway keep going! You will pass Bedgebury School playing fields and back entrance to school stable yard on left. Keep going! Then, past a lovely lake on the right..... Down hill and up hill! Then you will see a Timber Lodge type Office on left with a Car Park for staff and visitors just past it.

THE BOX PARK - is just a few hundred yards past the District Offices, follow track straight ahead of you. You may have to stop and unlock a metal barrier. The entrance to the Box Park is a few hundred yards further on left and has a Wooden Barrier style gate which you will have to unlock and lock again.

If the Box Park is full please drive on into Forest in order to turn round (plenty of space!) and go back to an unfenced area adjacent to the District Office Car Park which TROT permit holders may use **BUT ONLY** if the Box Park is full.
